The dance squad will perform the choreography *Flashmob In Light*, which is inspired by the number 10 for the 10th anniversary of Nuit blanche à Montréal, on March 2nd 2013 from 9pm to 1am. The contemporary dance choreography is created by Violaine Morinville. Many dancers will move within the external site of the Festival by performing the choreography 10 times at 10 various places. The dance tour starts at l'Esplanade of *la Place des Arts* to finish at *la Place des Festivals*.

Light effects creates an interactive animation with the dancers, while moving from one place to the other. Light and winter are the main themes for the FESTIVAL MONTRÉAL EN LUMIÈRE. Dancers wear light accessories to create a space like a choreographic installation. The goal to produce this performance is to bring awareness of the arts in the city as well as inspire people into original places.

Violaine Morinville has a Master Degree in dance from UQAM (specialized in Qi Gong and Somatics). She is a choreographer, teacher and reporter. She founded the Qi Motion\dance project, the dance color program, 20-20interarts, danse+arts platform and the Intl Interarts Festival. She explores visual arts, music and video to create choreographic installations or in situ events. She is a reporter for CIBL and les Meconnus.
