GENERAL INFORMATION

Tennis Clearpoint is a private club located on tranquil Killarney Gardens in Pointe Claire, just north of Lakeshore Rd., between Boul. St. Jean and Cartier Avenue.

Courts are open for play, weather permitting from 8:30 a.m. to 10 p.m. An announcement of special events and the status of the courts is recorded daily and can be accessed at 514-630-1233

All paid up members have a name tag which must be placed on the play board to regulate the flow of play to 30 minutes per court when there are players waiting. Detailed rules of the board system are posted in the club house.

Tennis Attire

Members and guests must wear white tennis attire; however, our juniors are permitted to wear 50% non-white tennis clothing if they wish. Flat soled tennis shoes are mandatory.

Guests

Guests of members may play a maximum of three times in a season (\$5.00 fee) but must wear proper tennis attire and shoes. The guest registration book, located in the clubhouse, must be filled out by the club member bringing the guest.

Court Availability and Lessons

After much discussion, the executive has decided that no more than two courts should be utilized for lessons at any one time. This includes junior lessons, adult lessons and team lessons. Court 5 is the designated lesson court that can be used by our teaching pros from 9 a.m. to closing. Court 4 may be used under exceptional circumstances. Other exceptional circumstances are interclub matches, evening or weekend round robins, special events and regular maintenance from 12:30 – 1:30 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily.

The head pro will be responsible for scheduling these lessons ensuring that

only one court and in exceptional cases two courts are utilized for lessons on eligible days.

Interclub Teams

Clearpoint will field a men's veterans' team and two daytime ladies' teams.

Round Robins

Organized round robins continue to be popular at Clearpoint. Tuesday mornings, Monday and Wednesday evenings are informal and social, while Friday evenings are more competitive with more advanced players encouraged to play on Fridays. A coordinator is on hand to arrange matches with numbers restricted to those present at 7:00 p.m. At least one court will be available for general play by the board for those not wishing to be a part of the organized play.

A social round robin, each with a different theme, is held once a month.

Junior Program

Our very popular junior lessons will again be coordinated by Michel Guindon, utilizing his West Island tennis club professionals. The junior program will commence with a fun "get acquainted" parent and child tournament and general registration on Saturday, May 31st from 1:30 p.m. to 5 p.m. Friends and non-members are welcome as well to try out the courts, meet the pros and register for membership and lessons if they wish.

Club Tournaments

Competitive club tournaments for men and women in singles, doubles and mixed doubles will be arranged again this year. Check the notice board for details and sign-up.
